Zucchini Pasta: Low Carb Recipe

2 zucchinis, peeled 1 tablespoon olive oil 1/4 cup water Salt and ground black pepper to taste

Directions

Cut lengthwise slices from zucchini using a vegetable peeler, stopping when the seeds are reached. Slice into thinner strips resembling spaghetti.

Heat olive oil in a skillet over medium heat; cook and stir for 1 minute. Add water and cook until zucchini is softened, 5 minutes. Season with salt and pepper.

Research Study: Determining the validity, reliability and sensitivity of an added sugar biomarker and BEVQ-15 in children and adolescents

VT is conducting a study to determine the validity and reliability of a beverage intake questionnaire and an added sugar biomarker in children and adolescents. Your child may be eligible to participate if s/he is between ages of 6-18.

The study involves four visits to the Virginia Tech campus, over a 2-3 week period. The total time commitment will be about four hours. Visit will include:

- Assessment of height and weight
- Providing information on food and beverage intake
- Providing information on health status
- Providing two fingerstick blood samples

Child and adolescent participants will be compensated \$50 for the completion of all study visits.
