A reminder to all Woodbine neighbors about the Town of Blacksburg's LEASH LAW http://tiny.cc/17c41x Section 5-200. - Leash law. (a) It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog to permit the dog to go or be in the town off the premises of the owner, unless the dog is kept secured by a leash, or led by other means of restraint (which may include an electronic leash or training device) not harmful to the dog.

COOL ICE CUBE FLAVORS: JEWEL TONE

Add some crunch to your cubes. Fill a tray halfway with water, add a cluster of pomegranate seeds, stir to spread them out, and freeze.

The fruit is moderate in calories, holds about 83 calories per 100 grams; slightly more than that of in the apples. It contains no cholesterol or saturated fats.
